ENTRANCE PROCESSION TO THE ALTAR (Please circle **ONE** option)

1. Groom's parents and bride's mother are seated just before the procession. The Bridesmaids and Maid of Honor come in single file up the aisle. Bridesmaids, Maid of Honor are met by the groomsmen and the Best Man at the altar. Then the bride enters on the arm of her father (or other person of choice) and is met at the altar by the groom.
2. Groom's parents are seated just before the procession. The Bridesmaids and Maid of Honor come in single file up the aisle. Bridesmaids, Maid of Honor are met by the groomsmen and the Best Man at the altar. Then the bride enters on the arm of her parents and is met at the altar by the groom.
3. Groom's parents and bride's mother are seated just before the procession. Then Bridesmaids and Groomsmen walk down the aisle as couples. Maid of Honor and the Bride (on the arm of her father) come singly down the aisle, and are met by the Best Man and Groom who are waiting at the altar.
4. Entire wedding party walks down the aisle as couples. The Priest leads the procession followed by the Groom with his parents. The Groom waits by the altar, followed by the attendants as couples. Lastly, the Bride enters accompanied by both her parents.
