2018 OLV SPRING SPORTS REGISTRATION DEADLINE EXTENDED TO MARCH 2

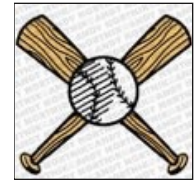
Calling all boys and girls in grades 5-8 who are interested in playing CYO Baseball or Softball: You have until Friday, March 2 to register for either OLV's Spring Baseball or Softball teams.

**** We are in need of players at all levels to field teams so please spread the word! Coaches are needed for JV Softball and JV Baseball ****

UPDATED PLAYER PARTICIPATION RULING: Beginning in 2018, CYO will once again allow players in baseball and softball to participate in the same sport in any other organized league with the exception of playing on a Junior High School, Middle School or Elementary School team.

Please visit www.OLVAthletics.com to register and click on PLAYER/COACH REGISTRATION on the horizontal tabs. Follow the provided instructions and include payment to OLV Dads' Club at the end via secure PayPal account (sorry, checks are not accepted). Payment needs to be made by the first practice.

The baseball and softball **seasons run from March 12 through May 6**, with Varsity playoffs through May 16. Generally, practices are 2-3 times a week plus games. A student must submit or have previously submitted a current health status/**physical, dated after April 15, 2017**, to be considered for a team.
