Offered to grades: Incoming 5-7

Offered to grades: Incoming 5-6

There will be games, crafts, and technology used to explore the students' novel math concepts. CREATIVE COLLABORATION CAMP

Minimum # of students: 10

Offered to grades: Incoming 3-6

Collaboration and creative problem solving meet in this fun summer camp! Start your summer off with creative challenges that get you up and moving, forcing you to solve problems, build trust, and communicate with your friends. Children will have to navigate their way through a "minefield" obstacle course while blindfolded, using only the help of their peers. Stranded on a desert island, they'll have to concoct a solution that helps everyone arrive safely. Finally, they will have to solve a mystery while working together to uncover clues. So, if you're ready for some challenging fun with your friends doing these activities and more, join us for some creative collaboration.

SHENANIGANS

Minimum # of students: 10

Offered to grades: Incoming 2-4

Enjoy a week full of goofy games, tons of tricks, plenty of pranks, silly songs, and creative paper crafts! This fun and exciting class will teach the students how to play Tiddlywinks, Pick-Up-Sticks, Marbles, and Jacks. They will master coin tricks, string tricks, number tricks, and card tricks. Our class will enjoy playing food pranks, gross pranks, and silly pranks. Students will learn Pig Latin, sing silly songs, practice tongue twisters, and master jump rope rhymes. The students will create cootie catchers, dollar rings, paper boats, and pinwheels. Come join the fun!

NATURE CAMP

Minimum # of students: 10

Offered to grades: Incoming 2-5

If you enjoy camping, hiking, and exploring the great outdoors, this camp is for you! Coordinated with the assistance of Wildlife Interpreter, Emily Guirey, you'll spend the week learning about animals, insects, plants, and the environment. Braid a Paracord survival bracelet, build bird feeders and bug houses, pitch a tent, learn to use a compass, partake in a scavenger hunt, and more. Be prepared to experience nature in new ways while gaining a deeper knowledge of and respect for God's beautiful Earth.

HIGH SCHOOL PLACEMENT TEST: MATH PREP

Teacher: Ms. Bradford

Minimum # of students: 5

Offered to grade: Incoming grade 8 ONLY

Any student planning to attend a Catholic high school will be required to take the High School Placement Test (HSPT) usually in the fall of his or her eighth grade year. This class will introduce the students to the two math portions of the *HSPT: Quantitative Skills and Mathematics*. Students will gain exposure to the types of questions asked on each section and develop strategies for completing the problems without a calculator and working efficiently within the time limits. The last day of the class students will take a practice HSPT in its entirety in a similar format to the actual test. **Often taken in conjunction with HSPT ELA Prep**

PRINCESS SPA RETREAT

Minimum # of students: 12 girls

Offered to grades: Incoming grades 1-4

Bippity, boppity, boo! This school year has flew! Now that the learning is done, it's time for some fun...and a little pampering too! After a tough year of learning, reward yourself with some pampering and relaxation. Join us for all things relaxation, Create bath products (even Cinderella needs to get clean after a day's work), paint like Rapunzel (let your spirit shine), test out your new legs with Ariel (while doing some yoga) plus much, much more! STRENGTH AND FITNESS

Offered to grades: 4 thru 6

Athletes will work on proper form, stretching techniques, and building endurance through teamwork and camaraderie. It's going to be a fun, fast paced week. This will take place in the gym as well as outdoors.

HIGH SCHOOL PLACEMENT TEST: ELA PREP

Taught by: Mrs. Scaramucci

Minimum # of students: 10

Offered to grades: Incoming grade 8 ONLY

This class is only offered to incoming 8th grade students interested in attending a local Catholic high school and will be taking the High School Placement Test (HSPT). The HSPT is a timed, multiple-choice test with several sections (see your choice high school for information about which sections they require). This summer course will expose students to the three sections regarding ELA: Verbal, Language, and Reading. We will go through vocabulary skills, synonyms and antonyms, analogies, review & refresh grammar rules for the language portion, and give reading strategies to help with reading passages quickly and efficiently. **Often taken in conjunction with Math HSPT Prep**

PROJECTS GALORE

Minimum # of students: 10

Offered to grades: Incoming 1-4

Spend the week creating with Projects Galore! Draw like Michelangelo, paint with Pop Rocks, design a pasta mosaic, and decorate with Kool-Aid. Participate in service projects, dig right in to planting projects, experiment with science projects, and construct original building projects. It will be a busy, fun, and creative week for all!
